



## Mobile Mission Maintenance VTC

is a Christian based Vocational Training Centre.

Our **purpose** is to instruct trainees in practical skills relating to the building industry to Government accreditation standards.

'Trades training' forms the basis of our courses, which are supplemented by teaching on small business management, computing, life skills and scripture.

Our **aims** are:

- To **empower** trainees in trades such as carpentry, joinery, bricklaying, plastering and tailoring up to a Trade Certificate level, with extension courses for those with the potential to achieve Craft Certificate level.
- To **encourage** trainees to observe and practice good trade skills and safe work habits, and to become quality trades-people with good Christian ethics.
- To **equip** trainees to be productive members of their communities and as a result to positively contribute to the nation's economy.
  - To **recognize** and encourage potential leadership within trainees and to further their skills and ministry.

## PRACTICAL TRAINING

In order to give students quality practical training, they spend considerable time learning from the experienced MMM projects work team. Students learn their trade through working on building projects for various churches, missions and community based programs. This practical work is part of the training program and no financial payment is given for any work that is done as part of the training.

Graduates of the VTC also have the opportunity to serve with the MMM Projects Team. In 2007, three of our Construction Management graduates joined the Projects Team, building a community school in Mozambique.

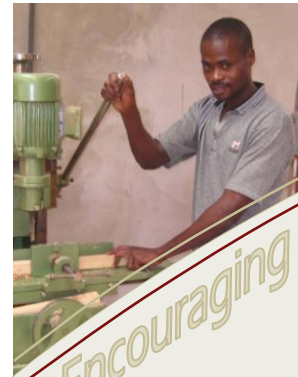

## TEVETA ACCREDITATION

We are a grade one institution, accredited with Technical Education, Vocational and Entrepreneurship Training Authority (TEVETA). Our students are certified by the Examination Council of Zambia.

## SUBSIDISED TUITION FEES

MMMVTC is a non-profit Christian mission seeking to empower, equip and encourage people. To this end our tuition fees are heavily subsidised through the generosity of many; ensuring our courses are affordable for those who need uplifting most.

## OUR COURSES

### BRICKLAYING & PLASTERING

This is a 2 year construction course for which able students can graduate with a Trade Test Certificate (G5, G6 or G7)

### CARPENTRY & JOINERY

Students are trained to construct and produce quality wood products. Students are able to graduate from this 2 year course with a Trade Test Certificate (G5, G6 or G7)



### CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT FOR SITE FOREMAN

This is a special 1 year multi-skill oriented course tailored to train construction site foremen. The course is designed for trade certificate graduates who wish to further their studies and skills in building and people management. The course covers disciplines such as electrical, plumbing, business management, bricklaying, carpentry and computing. Students can graduate with a Centre Certificate and have an option of a Trade Test Certificate.

### TAILORING

This 1 year course trains students to design, cut and make quality clothing. They can graduate with a Trade Test Certificate (G5, G6 or G7)



### WIN PROGRAM

The Women In Need (WIN) Program takes practical training to the people, providing literacy, sewing and other life skills to women in compounds around Ndola. The program offers a basic one year course as well as an advanced second year course.

## APPLICATION & ENROLMENT REQUIREMENTS

- ◆ Applicants should be at least sixteen years of age.
- ◆ Applicants need to possess a National Registration Card, and provide copies of such with their application.
- ◆ Applicants should be able to:
  - Read and write English;
  - Communicate clearly in English; and
  - Understand and follow verbal instruction.
- ◆ Applicants are to provide proof of completing a minimum of grade nine schooling, or grade twelve for CM course.
- ◆ Applicants are required to submit a letter of reference from their Pastor, Church Leader or a Community Leader.
- ◆ Married applicants need to have means of support for their families while they are participating in the course. Time off will not be given for outside employment.
  - ◆ Course tuition fees are payable on or before the first day of term. Terms are run as close as possible to the TEVETA calendar.
  - ◆ Courses commence in January each year.
